Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome back again to our 2022 school year, please note the following important information:

1. Pick up/Drop off, of our learners

Please ensure that you drive up the curb and park on the vacant lot adjacent to the school. Please avoid parking in the street and making U-turns as it obstructs traffic.

Do not give learners money to buy treats, learners are running through the traffic in the afternoons to go and buy from vendors.

Learners are to be dropped off before 07:30 and collected promptly at 14:00 or when they dismiss, learners will receive demerits for late arrival and collection.

We will be experiencing more rain this season, ensure that your child has a raincoat that is clearly marked and handy to put over their uniform. Learners are to be collected from class in the afternoon if it is raining.

3. Fees

Exemption forms are available on D6 Connect and the school website for download and to be returned with all documentation before 12 February 2022. Please use your family code when making payment to the school's bank account and verify on your statements that you are using the correct code and that payments are reflected. 
4. Assessment Plans
